The Malanka Celebration

The Malanka mid-winter celebration has been celebrated by people of Ukrainian descent for thousands of years.

In the ancient tradition, Malanka is the beautiful daughter of Mother Earth. Because the Evil One coveted her beauty, he captured her and held her prisoner. While the Evil One held Malanka prisoner, an endless cold winter fell upon the earth. But, her brother, Wasilchyk, bravely fought the Evil One and liberated Malanka.

With the liberation of Malanka, the earth once again could have spring! People celebrate this event and the return of spring with food, music, and dance—all life-affirming activities!

In certain traditions, Ukrainian people would dress up in costumes for to represent the Malanka legend. A young plough boy would be Wasilchyk and he would spread wheat kernels as symbol of fertility. Other costumes would be devils, gypsies, beggars, goats, and bears. The capture of winter was sometimes represented by a chained live bear!

In the Christian era, the day was somewhat transformed to celebrate the life of Saint Melania with many close parallels to the more ancient traditions.

Malanka is celebrated today by millions of people across the world and is perhaps the most important cultural celebration of Ukrainian tradition.

Candle Magic

I have always loved candles. I remember as a child, how the flame of a candle would mesmerise me and take me to another place.

Also, I remember how the candles in the church, that I attended and in which I experienced many transformations, would glow with an intensity of intent. I remember how I would save a some of my allowance to drop into the donation box that was associated with candles, take one of the reeds (wood sticks that aligned the box) and ritually, light the stick by an already burning candle, and then light my own selected candle. During the service, I would often watch “my candle” to see its flame dance, glow, and shine as if it was happy that I had lit it and brought it to life.



Practical Suggestions for Candle Magic

1. Before you light or buy your candle, look up the spiritual colour meaning. Align this to your intention. Use a wooden match, give thanks and marvel at the match's magic of lighting as you strike it against the box, let it burn a little and then use it to light the candle, make sure the candle is lit, and finally blow out the match with your mind as blank (or open) as you can make it.



2. Let your candle burn as long as you want; but never leave it unattended. ☺
3. When you are ready, blow the candle out as you would a birthday cake candle, but do not make a wish—*make a will*. By this I mean include the spirit of *I will* with your wish and further, try not the even use **specific** words, a visualization and pure intent for goodness is best. Words are okay, but as always second best with Candle Magic.
4. Just be your beautiful self—that gorgeous and wanted Child of the Universe that you are—in your intent. And let the loving Universe carry your intention forward with the smoke and ash of your candle.
